About Information Technology Standards Committee (ITSC)

- National Standards Body is Standards, Productivity & Innovation Board (SPRING Singapore)
- There are 10 Standards Committees under the National Standards Council, one of which is ITSC
- ITSC was formed in 1990, supported by IDA Singapore and SPRING Singapore
- ITSC is an industry-led effort made up of volunteer members from the industry
- ITSC promotes and facilitates national Infocomm standardisation programmes and the participation of Singapore in the international Infocomm standardisation activities

3 Strategic Thrusts - CI2

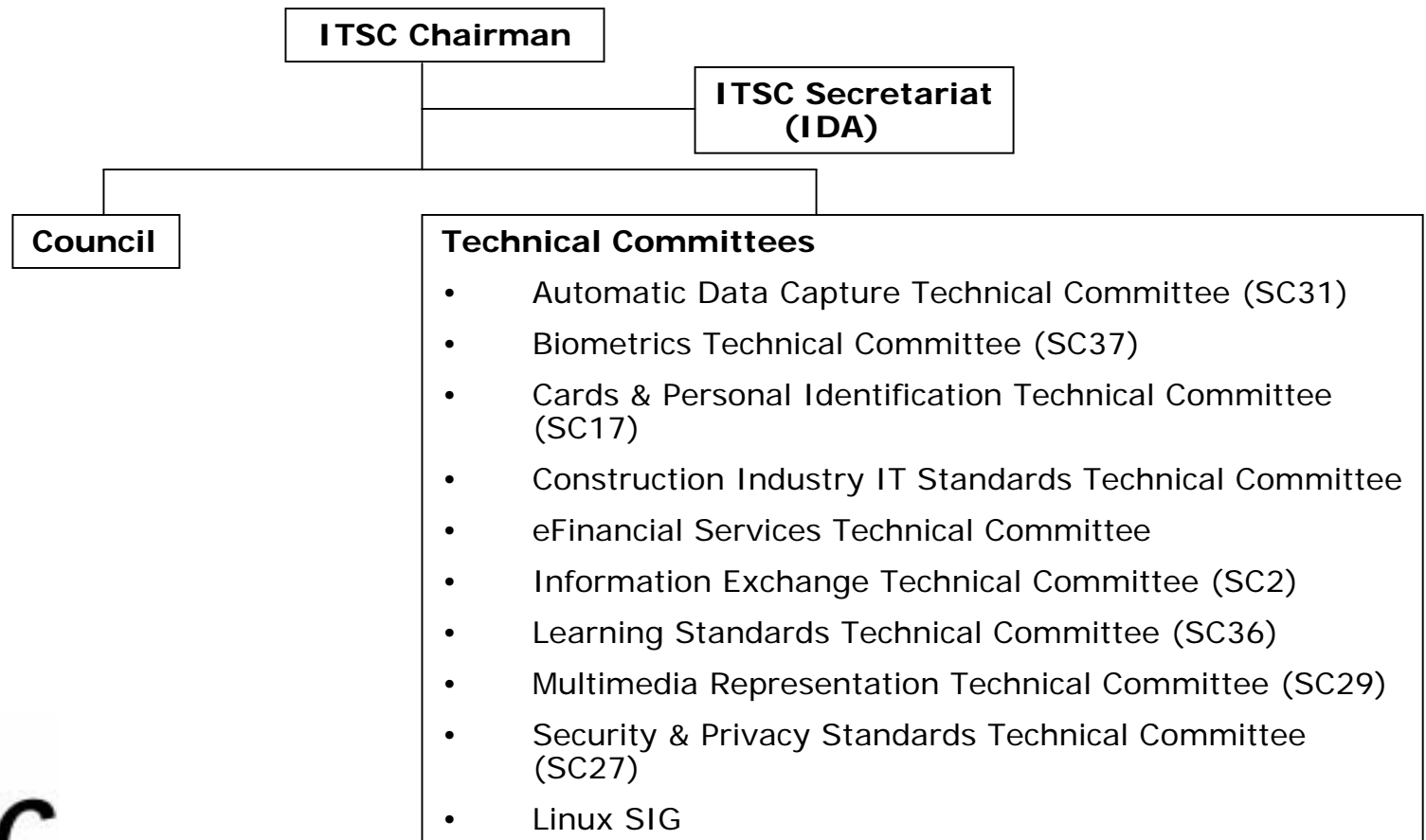
- **Connect** : to create industry awareness of standards through relationship building with industry and to participate actively in standards development through collaboration with worldwide standard bodies

ITSC 6th Term Structure

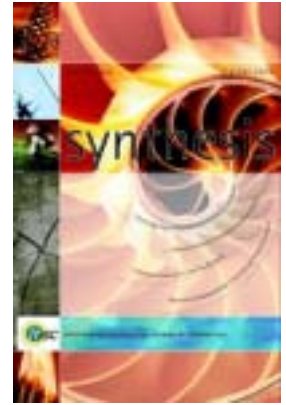


- ITSC is in its 6th term starting 1 April 2004 – 31 March 2007
