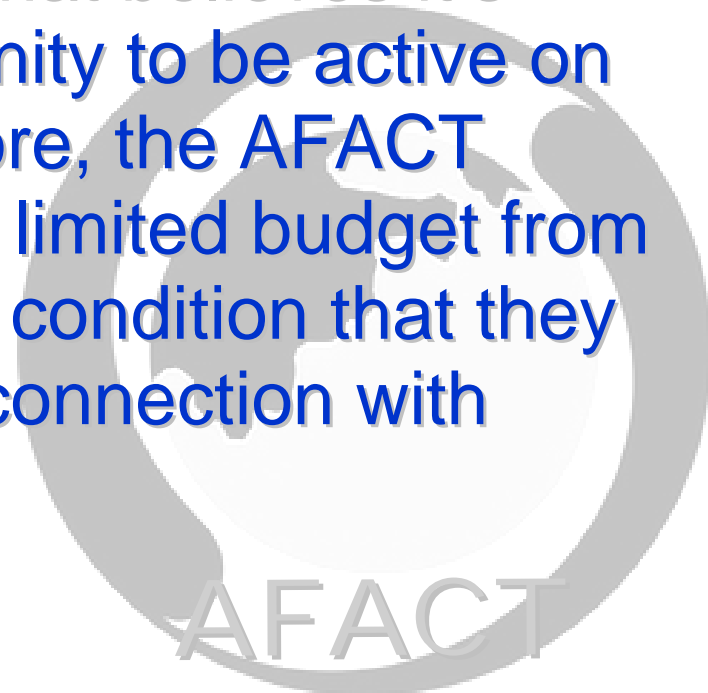






# Background
