Establishment of ISO/TC 154 WG6

- resolves to establish ISO/TC 154/WG 6 with the title “Trusted eCommunication”
- WG 6 includes projects “Trusted Communication Platform for Electronic Documents” and project “Trusted Mobile e-Document Framework” and “ISO 14533-3”.
- appoint **Ms. Jasmine Chang** as the convener of Working Group 6
- Allocation of the secretariat of ISO/TC 154/WG6 to South Korea (**KATS**)

- WG3 on ISO 15000-5 “Electronic Business Extensible Markup Language (ebXML) -Part 5: Core Components Specification (CCS)” has been successfully completed with the **publication as an International Standard in April 2014**
- Appreciation to the outgoing convener Ms. Mary Kay Blantz (ANSI) of ISO/TC 154/WG3 for her strong support and leadership in successfully completing the work on ISO 15000-5.
- noting that there was no majority to activate the ISO/PWI 6422-3; resolves to **disband ISO/TC154/WG 4**

- Combined NWIP and CD ballot for ISO 14533-3
 - Japan's proposal and WD draft for an ISO standard on ISO 14533-3 “Long term signature profiles for PDF Advanced Electronic Signatures (PAdES)”; resolves to initiate a combined NWIP+CD ballot and allocate ISO 14533-3 to the new ISO/TC 154/WG 6.
- Acceptance of ebXML parts as IS for "Fast Tracking"
 - agrees to accept the submissions of ebCPP, ebMS (Core), ebBPSS and ebRegRep for 'Fast Tracking' as International Standards with the following assumptions: OASIS will accept ISO/TC 154 recommendation to include AS4 as an appendix within ebMS (Core), and The material as submitted in the OASIS format is accepted by ISO/CS.
