1. Intended Project Purpose

It seems to be that in most advanced countries cities are growing larger and larger, while local regions are losing population. In Japan, for example, number of living people in local regions tend to be declining these days, while the regions seem to have a very good nature, nice living environment, a lot of hopeful chances to let people enjoy some activities, etc.

Experience programs which people could experience in regions might function well to vitalize regions as they seem to have the capability to attract more people for longer time to a region once they could prove to be appropriate to the region.

Experience programs may contain a lot of activities as are shown in Chart 1. They may traverse multiple domains of business areas, and inevitably have a large amount of data to describe and trade them among business partners.

It seems to be worth considering to set up a new project in the UN/CEFACT Forum with a lot of participants from the world.

2. Intended Project Scope

There may be a necessity to convince that experience programs could function well for the vitalization of regions.

The scope of experience programs should clearly be defined so that UN/CEFACT standardization process could be undertaken well by the participants.

The working results of SLH and DTI Information Process Project could form the building blocks for experience programs standardization process.

Once the scope could be defined well, the new project might be proposed to UN/CEFACT Forum.

3.Intended Geographical Focus

Therefore the focus could be global, and a lot of such countries could work together to standardize and facilitate the business process of them.

4.Intended Project Leadership

Japan and India have been talking on the theme and agreed to keep working on them. The leadership itself could be open to any appropriate person, but if there might not be or could not find in time, some person or group of persons of the countries could be assigned.

5.More Information

It seems to be preferable that a pilot project/ projects could be undertaken in a local region in the early stage of the project.


