Morning Session

- 1) [The progress on ASEAN Single window project - Electronic Phytosanitary Certificate]
Presented by Mr. Natthaphat Rojanasupamit

Mr. Natthaphat gave the presentation on the recent progress of e-Phyto Certificates which will be exchanged in ASEAN Single Window by the end of this year.

Ms. Eva's comments: If it is possible, the related organization responsible for the issuing the certificates should to discuss further in AFACT since they used UN/CEFACT Standard.

Mr. Mitsuru's comments: The information related e-Phyto and other e-Certificate should be collected from AFACT core-member country.

ETDA will consult UNESCAP about the questionnaires and send out the drafted questionnaires for BDC's review via email by this June.

- 2) [Get ready for Trade Facilitation Agreement (TFA)-1]
presented by Mr. Kongrit Chantrik

Mr. Kongrit gave the presentation on the details of TFA and its objective. He also shared the preparation experience of private sector in Thailand after TFA come in to force on Feb 22, 2017.

[Afternoon Session]

- 3) Electronic Bill of Delivery
presented by Mr. Young Kon Lee

Mr. Young Kon Lee gave the presentation on Electronic Bill of delivery. The project of e-Bill of Delivery will be proposed to UN/CEFACT and promises to deliver as follows: (1) Core data items in CCL (ACC, BCC, ABIE, BBIE, ASBIE) (2) BRS for e-BOD application (3) XML Schemas for e-BOD Messages and (4) Guideline for using e-BOD in mobile environment

Mr. Hisano's comments: The project need to differentiate its scope from the existing UN/CEFACT's projects since UNCEFACT's bureaus are concern that

- The project may be duplicated or Overlaps with other UNCEFACT's projects such as e-CMR
- The project may be out of Scope in the case of communication protocol

Also, the project need to provide a guideline for Telecommunication companies. AFACT members encourage to support this project.

Mr. Young's comments: The time limit of the project is that it should get the support before the end of May since it is required the budget from Korean government. Presently, the project get the support from Korea and Austria HOD.

4) The Discussion of AFACT e-Market place working and BDC-Supporting ASOCIO AEC eCom Alliance presented by Ms. Eva Yi-Yuan Yueh

Ms. Eva gave the presentation and start the discussion on Cross-border e-commerce related issues. The BDC identify the following activities should be made

- Survey of the problems that all stakeholders (e-market places, merchants and consumers) are facing presently including gap analysis of custom procedure for each country.
- Specification of the data set and the interface between platform and custom.
- Guideline for the stakeholders.
- Recommendation for the government

The eCom working group will provide a survey sheet by July 2017 and will be discuss the result of the survey in September. The white paper on this study should be available by the end of 2017)
